Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held in the Village Hall on Tuesday 11th August 2009.

1. The Chairman welcomed the Councillors' and 5 parishioners to the meeting.
Apologies received from Cllr. M. Gasper, Cllr. B. Cousins, Cllr. S. Hayward Rutter, Cllr. D. Wilkinson, and District Councillor P. Austin.
2. No declaration of interest was received.
3. C09/1078. Former Granary, Old Hall Farm, Bartholomews Lane.
Conversion of 2 barns to two holiday accommodation and associated site works.
A letter was read from Mr. & Mrs. M Gower.
The Parish Council felt that the information given was confusing and somewhat misleading. Through the Chair Mr Gower clarified certain aspects regarding the planning application.
4. C09/1119. New Farm, Blackheath Road, Wenhaston.
Erection of 12 holiday log cabins, shop and toilet/facilities block. Provision on site for 15 visiting caravans.
Letters were read from Mr. Alan Middleton Stewart and Mr & Mrs Havard.
Some Councillors' expressed their views concerning traffic, the environment, the number of caravans on site, while other Councillors' expressed views that they felt that the revised plan was away from the boundary of residents and that the log cabins would be an asset to the village. Also, that the light pollution would probably be less than the lights on the Sports area of the playing field.
A frank discussion took place.
A letter from Cllr. Cousins to be e mailed to the Councillors.

The Chairman made it clear that a decision would not be taken at this meeting but would be on the Agenda for the 19th August.

The meeting closed at 6.55pm
